Vincent Grall 2004 Sancerre **£30.00**

Pale straw yellow colour with green hints. A very aromatic nose of grapefruit, cut grass and Spring blossom. The palate is beautifully fresh, lively yet with good weight and a lovely length of flavour on the finish. Classic and racy Sancerre.

Domaine De Riaux Pouilly Fume 2004 **£29.50**

Domaine de Riaux owns some of the best terroir in the region. Their vines grow on what is known as 'silex' soil - a combination of limestone and flint that imparts the renowned 'smoky' or gunflint character to the wine.. With its fresh bouquet of newly mown hay and minerals, a full, rounded palate, ripe citrus fruit and a mouth-cleansing finish, this wine has the structure to last while offering delightful drinking right now.

Chablis Grand Cru Les Blanchots 2002 Laroche **£75.00**

Known as the queen of grand Cru's for its finesse and elegance. Intense, yet fresh and mouth filling with real 'steel' running through it. Michel Laroche is a former International Wine Challenge winemaker of the year.



Hamilton Russell Chardonnay 2004 **£38.00**

Anthony Hamilton Russel is a towering figure in South African wine and his international reputation owes much to this outstanding Chardonnay. Consistently brilliant year after year, the 2004 is delicious. A toasty, nutty nose reminiscent of great White Burgundy. Rich palate with weighty fruit and a hint of savouriness.

Far Niente Chardonnay 2001 Napa Valley **£95.00**

Apple, Lemon and soft oak aromas, together with a long clean finish are the classic hallmarks of this world-renowned wine.
