



## Wine Menu (1) Reds

**Chateau Siaurac 2000 Lalande de Pomerol £32.00**

Hugely impressive, great vintage Pomerol from the outer-lying region of Lalande. A deep, plummy Merlot with mouth-filling, ripe berry fruit and velvet tannins.

**Chateau Poujeaux 1998 Moulis £60.00**

Poujeaux is situated in Moulis, between Margaux and St Julien. It is the leading estate of the area and produces wines of Classed Growth quality. 1998 was a well-reputed vintage that is now nicely mature and drinking really well.

**Chateauneuf du Pape "Les Cailloux" 2001 Andre Brunel £58.00**

I absolutely adore this Grenache based blend and the 2001 is a really good vintage. Robert Parker describes Andre Brunel as 'one of the bright shining lights of Chateauneuf-du-Pape' and rates his Les Cailloux estate the full 5 stars. Having been in Chateauneuf since the 18th century, his canny family has gradually acquired some of the finest parcels of vineyard land in the village.

**Jaboulet La Chapelle Hermitage 2001 £135.00**

The flagship wine of Paul Jaboulet, a wine known all over the world and considered one of the world's finest. The hill faces south and has an exceptional exposure, which ensures not one ray of sunshine escapes the vineyards and yet it is sheltered from strong winds. The Jaboulet vineyard is spread over different "climates" to ensure exceptional complexity and finesse. Aged for 15 months in oak casks. The Northern Rhone is considered the home of the Shiraz grape and you would be pressed to find a finer example.



**Wynns Michael Shiraz 1997 £115.00**

Earning a reputation as the benchmark Coonawarra shiraz, Michael is fermented and then matured in new American oak for up to 18 months. It is deep red in colour with strong mulberry, peppery shiraz berry aromas enriched with coffee bean American oak character in the nose.

**Penfolds Bin 707 2001 South Australia £112.00**

A now world famous cuvee of 100% Cabernet Sauvignon and one of Australia's true icons.

**Penfolds Grange 1999 Speaks for itself POA**

Grange is both Penfolds' and arguably Australia's most famous wine and is officially listed as a Heritage Icon of South Australia. Grange boasts an unbroken line of vintages from the experimental 1951 and clearly demonstrates the synergy between Shiraz and the soils and climate of South Australia. Penfolds Grange displays fully-ripe, intensely-flavoured and textured Shiraz grapes in combination with new American oak. The result is a unique Australian style that is now recognised as the most consistent of the world's great wines. The Grange style is the original and most powerful expression of Penfolds' multi-vineyard, multi-district blending philosophy. The first 100% shiraz Grange since 1963, and an excellent follow on to the 1998 vintage.

**Chateau Lafaurie Peyraguey 1996 Sauternes POA**

Gorgeous honeyed fruit with a lingering floral finish, beautiful wine from a cracking vintage.

**Chateau Doisy Vedrines 2001 2me Cru Barsac £58.00**

One of the world's greatest sweet wines from a top vintage

**Feurheerde 1970 vintage Port £70.00**

Fully mature wine that is full of soft plummy fruit and a gorgeous finish, really astounding quality wine that really should cost a great deal more than it does. Highly recommended.

**Quinta do Vesuvio 1995 Vintage Port £50.00**

Very powerful with lots of black fruits and firm tannins.
