Weltevrede Rivers Edge Sauvignon Blanc 2003 **£15.00**

Key to this Sauvignon's exuberance and racy acidity is the hour at which it was picked - in the cool of early morning thus preventing oxidation and retaining maximum freshness. From the Jonker family's fourth generation estate in South Africa

Sacchetto Pinot Grigio Veneto 2004 Italy **£14.90**

This newly discovered Pinot Grigio is easily among Italy's most thrilling. It's bursting with ripe aromas and packed with fruit, a hint of white pepper and spice.

Domaine Pellehaut 2004 Cotes De Gascogne **£16.50**

This wine won an award for best Vin De Pays in France and it is beautifully dry crisp and refreshing

Sincerite 2004 **£16.50**

This is made in the same way as a French Sancerre from Sauvignon Blanc and in fact they age the wine on the skins of Sancerre to add more complexity to the wine. It's a cracking wine for a wine list as it is in a really lovely bottle and the wine itself is wonderful too.



Chablis 2003 Domaine William Fevre **£28.50**

(A personal recommendation)

Produced without oak to preserve its freshness. Powerful and expressive with a buttery almost honeyed character

Pazo de Senorans Albarino 2003 Rias Baixas **£28.50**

Albarino is Iberia's trendiest grape variety and it excels in the cooler, damper regions of northwest Spain especially Rias Baixas. Be prepared for masses of refreshing, intense flavours in a style reminiscent of a grand Chablis with just a hint of Viognier's exotic character.
