to a secret **CODEWORD**...

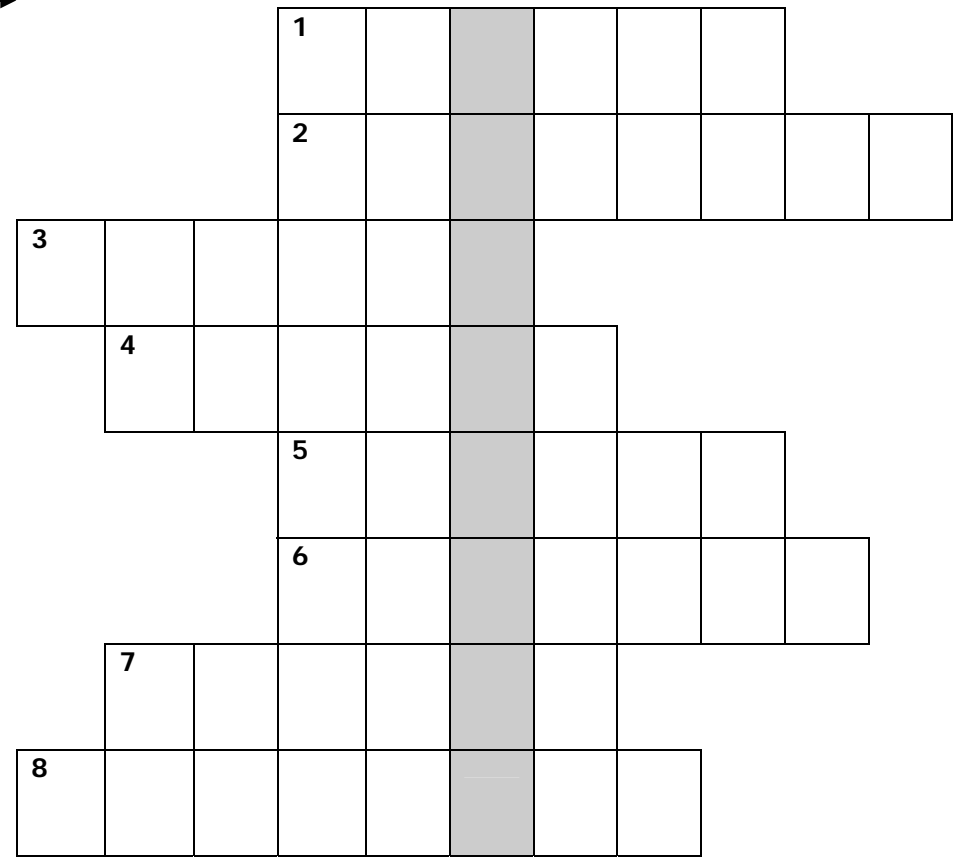
- Inside this book there are 8 questions that you will have to answer correctly to uncover the **codeword**.

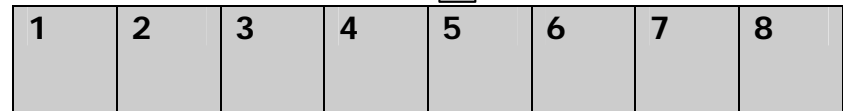
