Bletchley Park Onsite Bursary Visits

Terms and Conditions

We have limited funding available for schools who meet certain criteria linked to local deprivation and Pupil Premium levels, provided as part of our "Bletchley Park – GS Gives Bursary Fund". The following terms are specific to the ULTRA bursary and in addition to those outlined in our general Learning terms and conditions (which can be viewed on our website)

- 1. The eligibility of a school is at the discretion of Bletchley Park and will be confirmed in writing.
- 2. The Ultra Bursary covers the admission fee to Bletchley Park for all students (up to and including KS5) who are visiting from a school that is eligible for the bursary.
- 3. The Ultra Bursary does not include a visit to The National Museum of Computing.
- 4 .The Ultra Bursary includes a transport subsidy of up to £5 per student following an invoice of the total transport costs after your visit has occurred. To apply for the transport subsidy, you must email learning@bletchleypark.org.uk

Bursary Cancellations

- 5. In the case of the percentage of pupil premium children who visit Bletchley Park not matching the percentage of pupil premium pupils on roll, the bursary will not apply and regular costs will be invoiced by Bletchley Park.
- 6. You are able to cancel your booking up to 28 calendar days prior to your visit without penalty. Cancellations should be made in writing to learning@bletchleypark.org.uk.
- 7. If you cancel within 28 calendar days of your booked visit, the bursary will not apply and a 50% payment will be required.

Please note: Carers and staff are free of charge up to a ratio of 1:5 (additional adults are charged) and the required minimum ratio of adults to students is KS1/FS 1:5, KS2 1:6, KS3+ 1:10
